CLEANING METHODS FOR WHITE BOARDS

LAUZONITE WHITE BOARD :
(Limited 5 year warranty)

Clean the board using a mild soap mixed with hot water. If certain marks are still visible, we recommend using Varsol.

PORCELAIN WHITE BOARD :
(50 year warranty)

Clean the board using a mild soap mixed with hot water. If certain marks are still visible, we recommend using a paint thinner. In extreme cases Ajax or Comet can be used to clean your board. It is very important to always rinse the board with clean water when using paint thinner or Ajax. We recommend to dry the surface of the board with a clean soft cloth.

ADDITIONAL CLEANING HINTS:

- 1) It is important to always use a soft cotton cloth.
- 2) After cleaning the board, look on an angle to make sure there is no «shadow», otherwise your board will leave marks the next time you use it.
- 3) The lighting in the room could accentuate the «shadow» effect (the trace of the marker after you have erased it).
- 4) There are certain kinds of markers or colours that are more difficult to erase.
- 5) Regular use of your whiteboard must be accompanied by a regular maintenance.

RECOMMENDED MARKERS :

Pilot, Expo or Pentel brand markers. All dry-erase markers can be used on porcelain surfaces, but for optimal performance, we recommend the use of solvent-based dry-erase markers as opposed to water-based dry-erase markers (also called low-odors). Low odors markers do not perform as well as solvent-based, because the water takes longer to dry and the ink clings more aggressively to the board's surface, leaving behind a film.

REMOVING PERMANENT MARKER:

A quick and easy way to remove permanent marker from the board's surface is to write over the top of the permanent marker writing with a dry-erase marker and simply erase. You may also moisten a clean, dry cloth with isopropyl alcohol, and wipe the board in a circular motion to loosen marker residue. Rinse with clear water, and dry with a clean cloth. Repeat as often as necessary to remove all residues.

RECOMMENDED BRUSH :

A 3 coloured brush (the same one used for chalkboards).

RECOMMENDED FREQUENCY FOR MAINTENANCE :

Once a week or more according to the frequency that you use it.
